The King of Horror



Have you ever seen this man before? -NO!

Have you ever heard the name of Stephen King ? -NO! ?NO! ?

I am really surprised because all the civilized world knows this man as the king of HORROR!!!

He is a world famous short stories writer, a novelist, a screenwriter, an actor and a TV producer.

Some fact files. Stephen King was born in Portland, State Maine , the USA in 1947, the second son of Donald and Nellie Ruth Pillsbury King. He made his first professional short story sale in 1967 to Startling Mystery Stories. In the fall of 1971, he began teaching high school English classes at Hampden Academy, the public high school in Hampden, Maine. Writing in the evenings and at the weekends, he continued to produce short stories and to work on novels.

In the spring of 1973, Doubleday & Co., accepted the novel Carrie for publication, providing him the means to leave teaching and write full-time. He has published over 50 books since then and has become one of the world's most successful writers. King is the recipient of the 2003 National Book Foundation Medal for Distinguished Contribution to the American Letters and the 2014 National Medal of Arts.

Stephen lives in Maine and Florida with his wife, novelist Tabitha King. They are regular contributors to a number of charities including many libraries and have been honored locally for their philanthropic activities.

All in all his 350 million of books were sold and many of them were made into films.

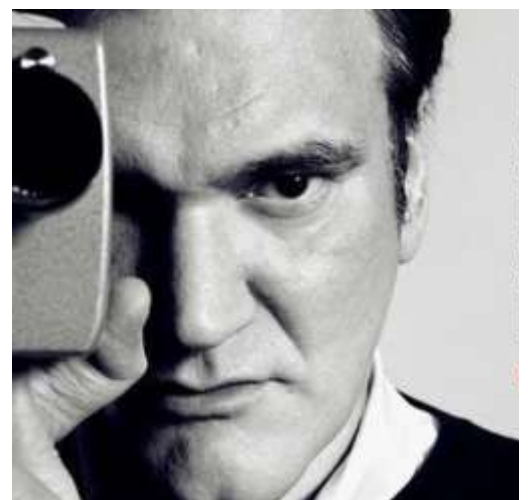

The king of drama, adventure and comedy – Steven Spielberg



Steven Allan Spielberg is an American filmmaker. He is considered one of the founding pioneers of the New Hollywood era and one of the most popular directors and producers in film history.

Spielberg was born on December 18, 1946 in Cincinnati, Ohio. His mother, Leah (née Posner, later Adler), was a restaurateur and concert pianist, and his father, Arnold Spielberg, was an electrical engineer involved in the development of computers. His family was Orthodox Jewish. Spielberg's paternal grandparents were Jewish Russian immigrants who settled in Cincinnati in the 1900s; his grandmother was from Sudylykiv, while his grandfather was from Kamianets-Podilskyi. In 1950, his family moved to Haddon Township, New Jersey, when his father took a job with RCA. Three years later, the family moved to Phoenix, Arizona.

His subsequent releases focused typically on science fiction/adventure films such as *Close Encounters of the Third Kind* (1977), *Raiders of the Lost Ark* (1981), *E.T. the Extra-Terrestrial* (1982), and *Jurassic Park* (1993), which became archetypes of modern Hollywood escapist filmmaking.

Spielberg is one of the American film industry's most critically successful filmmakers, with praise for his directing talent and versatility, and he has won the Academy Award for Best Director twice. Some of his movies are also among the highest-grossing films, while his total work makes him the highest-grossing film director in history. His net worth is estimated to be more than \$3 billion.

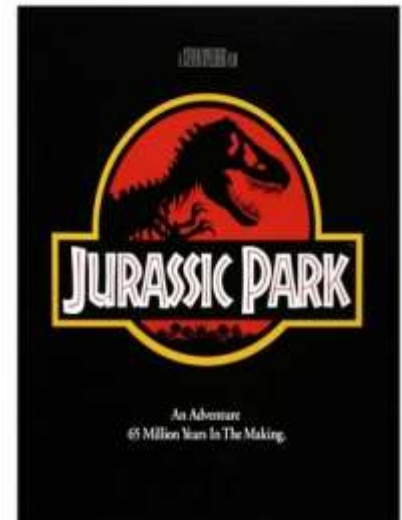

I suppose you have recognized this funny family. Yes, they are the Simpsons.

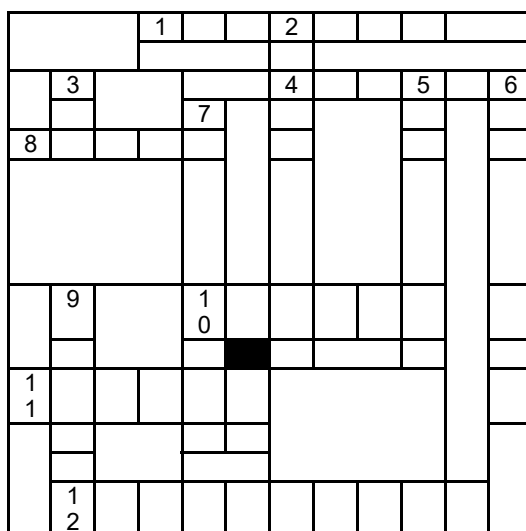
It is an American comedian cartoon serial, a sitcom. Originally it was created by the cartoonist Matt Groening for FOX Broadcasting Company under the name "Our Favorite Family," and periodically appeared on the screen in one form or another for over 20 years. The Simpson family first appeared on television as an independent short serial on The Tracey Ullman Show in April, 1987 and remained a staple (основной продукт) on this Show for three seasons until they premiered in their own half-hour series, on December 17, 1989. With the help of Jim Brooks and Sam Simon, Matt Groening's cartoon family turned into an instant success. It is the longest cartoon

serial. It has been on TV since 1989. In 2019 its 31st season started. According to the survey 94% of people love it very much! The number of the series shocks. All in all there are 684 of them.

Set in Springfield, the average American town, the show focuses on the antics and everyday adventures of the Simpson family: Homer, Marge, Bart, Lisa and Maggie. The serial reflects a real American lifestyle. Since the beginning, the series has been a pop culture icon, attracting hundreds of celebrities and stars. The show has also made name for itself in its fearless satirical view on politics, media and American life in general.
